### Summary:

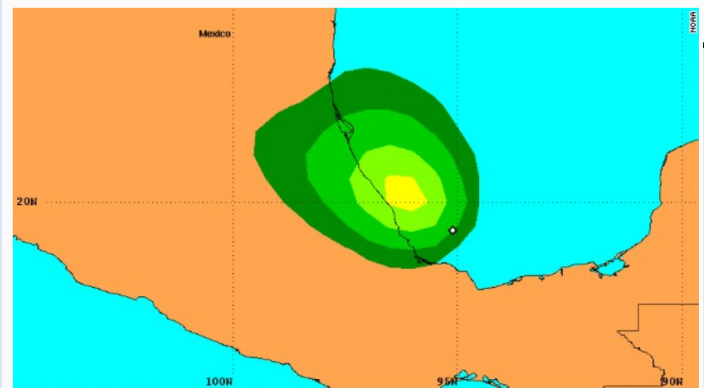
The tropical storm Fernand struck Mexico this past weekend causing thirteen deaths after mudslides buried homes in a village located in the state of Veracruz.
