

WHO GROWS THERE?

Globalization and commercialization of agricultural enables us to purchase and consume food from all over the world. It's easy to take for granted the trip that our food takes before it ends up on our plate. In an effort to become more familiar with our food's origins, we will explore a variety of whole food items that can be found at your local super market.

Next, write down the type of commercial agriculture that it derives (i.e., extensive grain cropping, plantation, specialty crop, market gardening, Mediterranean, Aquaculture).
